



Role Description

Kusafiri World Centre Volunteer

Kusafiri World Centre is one of the five World Centres of the World Association of Girl Guides and Girl Scouts (WAGGGS). Since 2012 Kusafiri has been 'popping up' using existing facilities to bring World Centre experiences to the Africa Region. The Centre creates international experiences for members of WAGGGS in countries across the continent of Africa.

Role Overview

The Kusafiri Volunteer (KV) will:

- Develop personally and professionally while building leadership skills and knowledge related to WAGGGS and the World Centres, Kusafiri and the local community of the host country.
- Develop their professional skills through active participation in the daily operations of Kusafiri World Centre and give service to Kusafiri, to the local community and to Girl Guides and Girl Scouts from around the world by sharing their skills and expertise.
- Bring dedication, enthusiasm, diligence, teamwork and professionalism to their role in order to take on personal and professional challenges.
- Have the opportunity to learn about different cultures and share the international friendship that Girl Guiding and Girl Scouting has to offer.

For this role, the commitment will run from May 2023 to September 2023. It will include:

- Pre-event - attending online preparation and team building in May/June/July (6 hours)
- During event - supporting the delivery of the programme at Celebrating Us: Connecting Communities in Kusafiri in August (11 days)
 - This includes arriving two days before the event and departing one day after for team building, in-person preparations, and debriefing.
- Post-event – evaluating the programme and helping to make recommendations for future programmes. (4 hours)



This Programme gives Volunteers the opportunity to reflect and develop their leadership throughout their experience focusing on the six WAGGGS Leadership Mindsets. WAGGGS believes that everyone can be more conscious about how they practice leadership and focusing upon leadership in six key areas allows leaders to be more prepared to achieve the Mission and Vision of WAGGGS.

The 6 WAGGGS Leadership Mindsets are:

1. Gender Equality Mindset
2. Responsible Action Mindset
3. Critical Thinking Mindset
4. Worldly Mindset
5. Reflective Mindset
6. Creative and Collaborative Mindset

Specific Responsibilities of a Kusafiri Volunteer

To work collaboratively and effectively with Volunteers and staff to deliver a high quality World Centre experience and to undertake specific duties as detailed in the following areas:

- Programme
- Guest Services
- Operations

Programme

To support the delivery of the programme through undertaking a range of responsibilities including but not limited to -

- Carrying out programme related tasks such as preparing resources, setting up and packing down rooms for sessions
- Maintaining resources
- Sourcing resources when necessary
- Supporting the delivery of programme sessions
- Supporting hosting any offsite programme activities including any visits to Community Partners
- Assisting patrols with duties such as flag ceremony and meal duties
- Participating in event briefing and event evaluation



Guest Services

To assist in providing participants with an enjoyable World Centre experience by -

- Meeting and greet incoming guests along with the host Member Organisation
- Departing outgoing guests along with the host Member Organisation
- Hosting meals and ensure people receive meals in line with their dietary requirements
- Ensuring meal time are occasions for sharing the international friendship of Girl Guiding and Girl Scouting
- Caring for the health and wellness of guests as required

Operations

To be engaged in operational matters which support the success of the event including

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- Assisting with the Kusafiri shop
- Creating a photographic record of the event with good quality pictures of Kusafiri activities and the creation of a short video
- Assisting in writing articles and updating Kusafiri's social media accounts
